VOLUNTEER FAQ

1. What is the St. George International Festival?

The St. George International Festival is an annual festival hosted by St. George Orthodox Church, in Pharr Texas. The festival has been held annually each December since the 1980's. Members of St. George are multicultural and offer the local community a vibrant celebration of cultures from around the world. It's a day filled with delicious food, lively music, colorful performances, local vendors selling holiday items for yourself or gifts.

This is the largest fundraiser for the church each year, and funds ongoing parish needs, improvement projects and ministries.

2. How can I volunteer for the festival?

There are several ways to get involved! You can:

- **Sponsor a Food Table**: Donate ingredients for a specific booth's cuisine. Contact the festival committee to donate!

3. Do I need any special skills to volunteer?

No special skills are required! Just bring your enthusiasm, a willingness to learn, and a love for cultural diversity. We'll provide training and guidance as needed.

4. How can I sponsor a food table?

To sponsor a food table, simply sign up with the festival committee and choose the country or culture you'd like to support. You'll receive information about the ingredients needed, and you can contribute what you can.

5. Can I volunteer with friends or family?

Absolutely! Volunteering with friends and family can make

the experience even more enjoyable. You can choose to work together on the same task or even represent different countries and share your experiences afterward.

6. What's the time commitment for volunteering?



The time commitment varies based on your chosen role. Cooking and food preparation might require a few hours leading up to the festival, while hosting a table will be during the festival itself, typically a half-day shift.

- Make sure to prepare a reasonable quantity, as your goodies will be shared with festival attendees.
- If you can, please package your baked goods in a way that keeps them fresh and presentable. You can use decorative containers, bags, or boxes.
- Include a note or label with a brief description of the ingredients and the cultural significance of your baked goods. Share a fun fact or story about the recipe or the country it represents!

No, the St. George International Festival is free to attend! Food and drinks are available to purchase, but our church tours, vendor booths and entertainment are all free for the community to enjoy.

2. How do I know the prices for meals at the food booths?

Each food booth will have clear pricing displayed for their meals as well as a full menu of all the food menu offerings at the Information and Ticket Desk. Prices are typically indicated for

individual dishes or combo meals.



3. Can I purchase meal tickets in advance to save time at the festival?

Yes, we highly encourage attendees to purchase meal tickets at the ticket booth to expedite the

ordering process. This can help you skip the line and enjoy your food faster.



Meal tickets can be purchased at the festival's Information Booth, conveniently located near the entrance. Look for the booth with the "Meal Tickets" sign.

5. What are the benefits of buying meal tickets in advance?

2. Submit Your Application:

Complete the <u>online application</u> that includes the following information:

- Your business name and contact information.
- A description of your products or services, emphasizing their cultural or holiday relevance.

3. Application Review:

Our Festival Committee will review all vendor applications to ensure they meet our guidelines and align with the spirit of the event. We prioritize diversity and cultural representation in our vendor selection process.

4. Confirmation and Payment:

If your application is approved, you will receive confirmation and payment details. Vendor fees are \$50 per booth for vendors that are selling items. Non-profit booths do not incur a vendor fee. Payment instructions will be provided once approved.



5. Prepare for the Festival:

Once your vendor space is confirmed, start preparing your booth or exhibit for the festival. Consider how to make your display engaging, culturally relevant, and family-friendly.

6. Festival Day:

Arrive at the festival before 9:00 a.m. on the day of the festival with time to prepare your booth. All booths are located in our parking lot, so please park your cars in the grass behind your booth, or in the parking lots next door. Our festival staff will be available to assist with any questions or concerns.

7. Engage with Attendees and Enjoy the Festival:

On the day of the festival, interact with attendees, share the cultural or holiday significance of your products, and create a welcoming and inclusive atmosphere.
