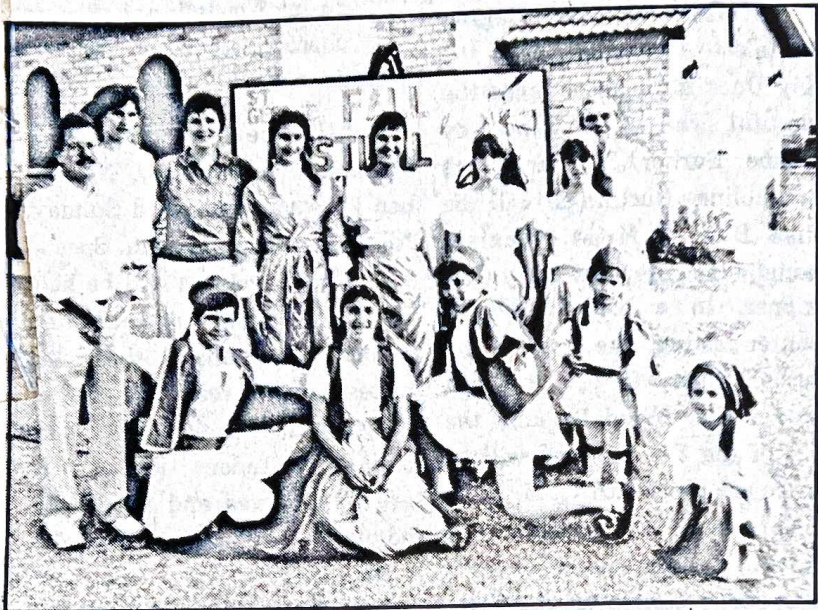


# Byzantine fall festival Nov. 7-8
